

Sound Art Composition Course for 8-11 year olds. Children can start practising composing at any level of musical training. Basic skills of composition are: to listen, to explore, and to organise. "Music is organised sound," it does not necessarily to have a key, a meter, and to be notated in traditional staves. Children will compose a sound art music piece, which is presented in a graphical score with their invented notations. They will be encouraged to talk about their piece a bit, and perform their composition in front of class at the end of the workshop.

This workshop takes place over a period of 8 weeks, with a two hour session each week. The fee for the whole course is £40 per child.

The course is taught by Dr Vanissa Law who has been involved in research including creative use of gesture in music making for people with special musical needs (developmental disability) as well as teaching recording techniques and sound design, music, science, electroacoustic music, music theory and musicianship at university.
